Thank you for your August 5, 6, 7, & 14, 2013, responses to Ohio EPA's June 19, 2013, Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included waste analysis documentation and a photograph demonstrating that the containers used to accumulate used oil located in the foundry have been labeled with the words "Used Oil".

My review of this documentation reveals that Ashland Operations, Pentair Flow Technologies has now abated all violations discovered during the May 21, 2013, and May 28, 2013, inspection as listed below.
