Thank you for submitting the requested information received by Ohio EPA on September 17, 2013. You submitted this information in response to my August 30, 2013, Notice of Violation. You stated in your response that you are planning to filter and reuse or burn for energy recovery in an oil burner the used oil you generate from now on. Please refer to the guidance document I provided you, titled Burning Used Oil in a Space Heater, July 2009, for specific requirements if you decide to install a used oil furnace. In addition, be aware that any waste generated from the used oil filtration will have to be properly evaluated before disposal.

My review of this documentation reveals that Kotten Enterprises has abated the violation discovered during the August 14, 2013, complaint investigation as listed below:
