Dear Mr. Conway:

On August 8 and October 3, 2013, I inspected Mr. T Painting & Sandblasting located at 123 Bedford Glens Road, Bedford, Ohio. The purpose of this was to determine if this facility was in compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste, universal waste and used oil laws and rules as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

This facility generates hazardous waste solvent from the cleaning of painting equipment. This facility is considered a conditionally exempt small quantity generator because normally less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste is generated in a calendar month. Please see the enclosed checklist for this type of generator.

The following violations were found:

1. **Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3734.02(E) and (F) – Disposal of hazardous waste.**  
ORC 3734.02 (E) and (F) state that no person shall establish or operate a hazardous waste facility without a permit and that no person shall store, treat, or dispose of hazardous waste except at a facility with a hazardous waste permit.

Mr. T Painting and Sandblasting violated ORC § 3734.02(E) and (F) by having the bung of its drum of hazardous waste solvent open on August 8, 2013. Since this waste solvent evaporates, this open container was considered disposal to the air. On August 8, 2013, we closed this drum and on October 3, 2013, I saw that the drum was closed. This documents your correction of this violation.

2. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels.**  
This rule requires containers, above-ground tanks and fill pipes for underground tanks used for used oil to be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil."

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
Mr. T Painting and Sandblasting violated this rule on October 3, 2013 by having a drum of used oil that was labeled as oil and not the required used oil. You corrected this violation during that inspection.
