

Subject: Failure to Submit TTHM/HAA5 Sample Monitoring Plan

LOCKBOURNE VILLAGE PWS is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-81-24 (D)(9) for failing to submit a copy of a sample monitoring plan for Total Trihalomethanes (TTHM) and Total Haloacetic Acids (HAA5). As a public water system using surface water sources, you were required to submit a signed copy of the plan by September 30, 2011. LOCKBOURNE VILLAGE PWS was notified of these requirements by letter on June 13, 2011.

In order to return to compliance, LOCKBOURNE VILLAGE PWS must immediately submit a signed copy of your Stage 2 sample monitoring plan.
