NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Mummert:

Per our telephone conversation today, Harsco Corporation is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-34-11(G). This rule requires monthly operating reports be submitted each month as long as fluids are being injected as part of a soil or ground water remediation project. According to part (3) of this rule, the owner must submit the following information monthly while fluids are being injected:

- (a) A description of the fluids injected into the Class V wells;
- (b) The volume of fluid injected into the Class V wells;
- (c) The rate of injection into the Class V wells; and
- (d) Any monitoring results.

In addition, part (4) of this rule states that you submit the information required by paragraph (L) of this rule. Paragraph (L) requires that you provide specific inventory information for each injection well, including but not limited to the latitude and longitude to the nearest second for each well.

In order to return to compliance with Underground Injection Control (UIC) rules, you must provide the inventory information required in OAC Rule 3745-34-11(L) as well as monthly operating reports for each of the following months: October 2008; November 2008; December 2008; January 2009; February 2009; March 2009; April 2009; May 2009; June 2009; July 2009; August 2009; September 2009; October 2009; November 2009; as well as all future reports while injection is taking place.

When injection ceases, the wells must be closed in compliance with OAC Rule 3745-34-11(N).
