Re: Klug Charter Bus Service – **NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

Dear Mr. Klug:

On October 24, 2007, Ohio EPA staff conducted an inspection of your Charter Bus Service business to determine compliance with applicable Underground Injection Control (UIC) rules and regulations. The following was determined:

Klug Charter Bus Service Company is in clear violation of OAC Rule 3745-34-13(A) which prohibits motor vehicle waste disposal (MVWD) into a Class V injection well and prohibits the injection of wash water wastes into or above an underground source of drinking water without a permit to operate. Based on visual inspection of the many floor drains, it was apparent that there was a history of MVWD into a Class V injection well and active injection of bus wash waters without a permit to operate.

With this notice, you must immediately cease injection of MVWD fluids or wash fluids into a Class V injection well (your septic system). Any future unauthorized injection could result in the appropriate enforcement action which includes civil penalties not exceeding \$10,000 per day per violation and criminal penalties that could include up to one year in jail and/or \$25,000 per day per violation.


Within 14 days upon receipt of this Notice of Violation, you must provide this office with a detailed Closure Plan that will include a schedule of events in closing the Class V injection well. Your consultant, Mr. Dave Canter of Environmental Services, has indicated to Ohio EPA that he will suggest that Klug Bus Service connect to the sanitary sewer line adjacent to your property. Ohio EPA has no opposition to this suggestion, however, it must be presented in the form of a Closure Plan.
