Dear Mr. Woodruff:

This letter is to memorialize the phone conversation of ~~November~~ November 2, 2010, with your consultant, Ryan Hillard of Hoppes Engineering. Within thirty (30) days, Woodruff Enterprises should exercise one of the four options to regain compliance with Rule 3745-34-11 of the Ohio Administrative Code:

1. Submit to the Division of Surface Water (DSW), Southwest District Office (SWDO) a completed Permit to Install (PTI) application to install the Water Recycle System proposed by your consultant Hoppes Engineering to recycle all waste water from vehicle repair and wash areas of the facility. The PTI Application is to be sent to:

2. Connect to Springfield's sanitary sewer system; or
3. Submit a permit to operate application for a Class V injection well per OAC rule 3745-34-12 and -16 for the disposal of industrial waste into the present sanitary system at the facility. This permit application should include a closure plan per OAC rule 3745-34-11(N) for disconnecting all floor drains and shop sinks within the vehicle maintenance areas of the facility. 4. Submit a closure plan to close the dry well currently receiving industrial waste and motor vehicle waste from the facility per OAC 3745-34-11(N). This closure plan should be sent to:

Again, you are reminded that Pursuant to Rule 3745-34-11(C) of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), Woodruff Enterprises is not permitted to inject industrial and motor vehicle waste fluids through floor drains and shop sinks connected to a septic system and or dry well. Discharge of waste fluids generated from the repair or maintenance of any motor vehicles is illegal pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3734-34-11(C). Woodruff Enterprises is also not authorized to discharge industrial waste waters such as those generated from vehicle washing or floor washing without a Class V permit to operate according to OAC 3745-34-11(A).

Please be aware that enforcement action will escalate until this matter is resolved. Enforcement action may include Director's Findings and Orders which will include a suggested monetary penalty or referral to the Attorney General's Office. Owners or operators of illegal and unpermitted disposal wells that fail to comply with Ohio's water pollution control laws and regulations are subject to civil penalties of up to \$25,000 under Ohio Revised Code Section 6111.99 plus the costs associated with meeting the terms and conditions of the Director's orders.
