Dear Mr. Mazur:

The Marina Dist. Project Toledo has failed to submit the annual O&M report as required under the Operation and Maintenance Agreement (OMA) entered into by the City of Toledo and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) on May 7, 2008. This failure is a violation of the OMA, and in accordance with Section 8 of that OMA, a failure to comply with the OMA may constitute a failure to maintain an applicable standard in accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3746.12(B).

In order that the Marina Dist. Project Toledo may return to compliance with the OMA as quickly as possible, Ohio EPA requests that the Arena Project Toledo submit the annual O&M report to Ohio EPA at within 30 days of receipt of this letter.

Please be aware that the time Ohio EPA staff have spent on addressing this violation of your OMA and any time that may be spent in the future by Ohio EPA, will be billed to your Voluntary Action Program OMA account.
