**RE: NOTICE OF VIOLATION/FAILURE TO REMIT RESPONSE COSTS  
GLACIER VANDERVELL, INC. - CALDWELL, OHIO**

Dear Mr. Cronmiller and Mr. Lawrence:

The Glacier Vandervell Site Respondents have failed to remit payment of response costs to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency in accordance with the Director's Final Findings and Orders (DFFOs) effective on October 22, 2009. In accordance with Section XVII of the DFFOs, the Respondents are to remit a check to Ohio EPA within 45 days of receipt of the itemized accounting of the response costs incurred after December 10, 2007 and before January 1, 2010.

I have attached a copy of the original invoice sent to Mr. Cronmiller on February 26, 2010. The total amount outstanding is \$34,247.39. This amount was due on April 12, 2010. Please pay \$34,247.39 within thirty (30) days of your receipt of this correspondence.

Failure to remit payment of response costs is a violation of the October 22, 2009 DFFOs and may result in interest being accrued on the amount past due, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 131.02(D) or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA), 42 U.S.C. §9607, whichever is applicable. Gould Electronics, Inc. and Mahle Industries, Inc. will remain in violation of the DFFOs until Ohio EPA receives payment in full.

In accordance with the Reservation of Rights Section of the DFFOs, Ohio EPA specifically reserves the right to seek legal and/or equitable relief to enforce the terms and conditions of the DFFOs. If Ohio has not received payment in full within thirty (30) days of your receipt of this correspondence, Ohio EPA may initiate one of its' available enforcement options.
