- 3. Report all changes in address, telephone number or employment income to the Probation Department within 72 hrs.
- 4. Obtain a general equivalency diploma (GED) or obtain High School diploma.
- 5. Obtain and keep steady employment. If unemployed, show proof of job searching or enrollment at the unemployment office.
- 6. Use no illegal drugs, alcohol, no narcotics without a doctor's prescription and do not go into bars. You will be subject to random urine screening by the Probation Department and shall not take any substance to falsify testing.
- 7. Be evaluated and complete treatment at: _____
You will authorize the release of information about your treatment to this court.
- 8. Attend AA/NA meetings. Show proof to Probation Officer.
- 9. Make restitution in the amount of \$ 2,000 To: Ohio EPA - in full by end of probation.
- 10. Do not have a Checking Account.
- 11. No contact directly or indirectly with the complaining witnesses, victim and/or any other state witnesses in this case. Particularly no contact with _____ their residence or their place of employment.
- 12. No not possess any weapon or dangerous ordinances as defined in ORC 2923.11.
- 13. Do not possess any weapon or dangerous ordinances as defined in ORC 2923.11 for life.
- 14. You may be placed under house arrest or curfew at any time at the discretion of the Probation Department.
- 15. You will be subject to random home visits if felt necessary by the Probation Department and will be subject to search of your person, vehicle and/or place of residence, where such residence is under your control, at any time by the Probation Department or any Law Enforcement Officer.
- 16. Pay ~~all fees~~ and Court costs as directed by the Court.
- 17. Do not operate a motor vehicle after consuming any alcohol.
