

PREAMBLE

It is agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

These Director's Final Findings and Orders (Orders) are issued to P.H. Glatfelter Company and NewPage Corporation (Respondents) pursuant to the authority vested in the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) §§ 3734.13 and 3745.01.

II. PARTIES BOUND

These Orders shall apply to and be binding upon Respondents and successors in interest liable under Ohio law. No change in ownership of the Respondents or of the Facility shall in any way alter Respondents' obligations under these Orders.

III. DEFINITIONS

Unless otherwise stated, all terms used in these Orders shall have the same meaning as defined in ORC Chapter 3734. and the rules promulgated thereunder.

IV. FINDINGS

All of the findings necessary for the issuance of these Orders pursuant to ORC Sections 3734.13 and 3745.01 have been made and are outlined below. Nothing in the findings shall be considered to be an admission by Respondents of any matter of law or fact. The Director of Ohio EPA has determined the following findings:

1. Respondent Glatfelter owns and operates a business located at 401 S. Paint St., Chillicothe, Ross County, Ohio (Facility). Respondent NewPage formerly owned and operated the Facility.
2. Respondents are each a "person" as defined in ORC § 3734 01(G) and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-50-10(A).
3. In early 2006, Respondent Glatfelter purchased the Facility from Respondent NewPage. Respondent NewPage had previously purchased the Facility from MW Custom Papers, LLC on or about May 2, 2005. At the Facility, MW Custom Papers, LLC generated "hazardous waste" as that term is defined by ORC § 3734.01(J) and OAC rules 3745-50-10(A) and 3745-51-03 and was identified as a small quantity generator of hazardous waste.
4. On April 7, 8, 14 and May 16, 2005, Ohio EPA conducted a compliance evaluation inspection at Vexor Technology, Inc. located at 955 West Smith Road, Medina, Ohio. (Vexor). As a result of this inspection, Ohio EPA determined that MW Custom Papers, LLC had, on March 4, 2005, transported or caused to be transported two containers of corrosive hazardous waste (D002) to Vexor. Vexor does not hold a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit issued in accordance with ORC Chapter 3734. The containers of waste were transported as non-hazardous waste and were accompanied by non-hazardous shipping papers.
5. Because MW Custom Papers, LLC failed to properly evaluate its waste to determine if it was hazardous and transported or caused to be transported the containers of hazardous waste to Vexor, a facility not operating under a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit issued in accordance with ORC Chapter 3734., the Director has determined that Respondents Glatfelter and NewPage also violated OAC rule 3745-52-11 and ORC § 3734.02(F).
6. Because the containers of hazardous waste were transported from Vexor to Chemtron Corporation, a facility operating under a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit, the Director has determined that no further action is required of Respondents Glatfelter and NewPage to abate the

violations as referenced in Finding No. 5. of these Orders.

V. ORDERS

Respondents shall achieve compliance with Chapter 3734. of the ORC and the regulations promulgated thereunder according to the following compliance schedule:

1. Within 30 days after the effective date of these Orders, Respondents shall pay to Ohio EPA the amount of \$4,400.00 in settlement of Ohio EPA's claims for civil penalties, which may be assessed pursuant to ORC Chapter 3734., and which will be deposited into the hazardous waste cleanup fund established pursuant to ORC § 3734.28. Payment shall be made by an official check(s) made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio" for a total amount of \$4,400.00. The official check(s) shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, Office of Fiscal Administration, Department L-2711, Columbus, Ohio 43260-2711, together with a letter(s) identifying Respondents. A copy of this check(s) shall be submitted in accordance with Section X. of these Orders.

VI. TERMINATION

Respondents' obligations under these Orders shall terminate upon Ohio EPA's receipt of the official check(s) required by Section V. of these Orders.

VII. OTHER CLAIMS

Nothing in these Orders shall constitute or be construed as a release from any claim, cause of action or demand in law or equity against any person, firm, partnership or corporation, not a party to these Orders, for any liability arising from, or related to, the operation of the Facility.

VIII. OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS

All actions required to be taken pursuant to these Orders shall be undertaken in accordance with the requirements of all applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations. These Orders do not waive or compromise the applicability and enforcement of any other statutes or regulations applicable to Respondents Glatfelter and NewPage.

IX. MODIFICATIONS

These Orders may be modified by agreement of the parties hereto. Modifications shall be in writing and shall be effective on the date entered in the journal of the Director

XI. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

Ohio EPA and Respondents each reserve all rights, privileges and causes of action, except as specifically waived in Section XII. of these Orders.

XII. WAIVER

In order to resolve disputed claims, without admission of fact, violation or liability, and in lieu of further enforcement action by Ohio EPA for only the violations specifically cited in these Orders, Respondents consent to the issuance of these Orders and agree to comply with these Orders. Compliance with these Orders shall be a full accord and satisfaction for Respondents' liability for the violations specifically cited herein

Respondents hereby waive the right to appeal the issuance, terms and conditions, and service of these Orders, and Respondents hereby waive any and all rights Respondents may have to seek administrative or judicial review of these Orders either in law or equity.

Notwithstanding the preceding, Ohio EPA and Respondents agree that if these Orders are appealed by any other party to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission, or any court, Respondents retain the right to intervene and participate in such appeal. In such an event, Respondents shall continue to comply with these Orders notwithstanding such appeal and intervention unless these Orders are stayed, vacated or modified.

XIII. EFFECTIVE DATE


The effective date of these Orders is the date these Orders are entered into the Ohio EPA Director's journal.
