Dear Mr. Rush:

On December 6, 2011, I met with you to discuss the actions needed to be taken to bring your facility's wastewater discharge into compliance with the conditions of your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. Your facility is currently in significant non-compliance with permit limitations and the compliance schedule requirements. The restaurant wastewater discharge is served by a septic tank prior to discharge into a tributary to the Maumee River.


As we agreed during the meeting, you have the option of installing a treatment system to achieve compliance with the permit limits or install facilities to pump the wastewater to the Village of Cecil. As was indicated, your compliance with the schedule in your permit is overdue and expeditious action is needed. We expect completion of one of the above mentioned options no later than December 15, 2012.

Please inform this office in writing no later than December 31, 2011, of the actions, with time frames, you plan to complete to bring your facility into compliance.

Your permit expired on February 28, 2011. A renewal application Form 1 and Form 2E is enclosed for you to complete and submit no later than January 31, 2012. A renewal fee of \$200.00 should be submitted with the application.
