**NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

Dear Mr. McVoy:

During a review of Ohio EPA's electronic discharge monitoring report (eDMR) information for the above referenced facility at 600 State Road, Ashtabula Township, Ashtabula County, Ohio EPA notes that the facility is in significant noncompliance (SNC) for total suspended solids. U.S. EPA defines significant noncompliance for total suspended solids if a facility exceeds the limits established by the facility's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit by more than 40% for two or more months during the consecutive quarter review. The review period reviewed is April 2011 through August 2011. Ohio EPA notified you of this via a Notice of Violation (NOV) dated October 24, 2011. Ohio EPA also outlined compliance issues with your NPDES permit in a compliance inspection letter dated July 29, 2011. To date Ohio EPA has had no response from this inspection.

***Due to the nature of NPDES permit violations, including failure to follow your compliance schedule, and lack of a timely response, and continuing violations, this office will be referring this matter to our central office for escalated enforcement.***
