Dear Mr. Nixon:

This letter is written in regard to an industrial storm water inspection that I conducted at the City of Lancaster's Water Pollution Control Facility, on December 1, 2011. The inspection was conducted in order to determine compliance with your industrial storm water general permit. The following items were noted during the inspection:

A dumpster was located on-site and had closed lids. No staining on the pavement around the dumpster was noted.

Unloading and loading was able to be conducted in a closed area.

There was no potential for activities or materials to be exposed to storm water or snow at your facility that could discharge untreated to waters of the state. You may apply for an Industrial No Exposure Certification or NOE. You can obtain the form and instructions at the following link: <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/storm/stormform.aspx>.

If you decide to apply for the Industrial No Exposure Certification, you will not need to renew your industrial storm water general permit 4GR00371\*DG.
