Dear Mr. Allen:

This letter is written in regard to an industrial storm water inspection that I conducted at the Indiana and Ohio Railway WCH HSE Facility, on November 30, 2011, located at 222 West Paint Street, in Washington Court House, Ohio. The inspection was conducted in order to determine compliance with your industrial storm water general permit. Your facility appears to repair locomotives. The following items were noted during the inspection, also please see attached pictures:

I noted that the facility consists of a small building and several spurs of railroad tracks.

I noted that there was a spill kit in the rear of the building.

There were used locomotive parts stored on racks and pallets outside in the rear of the building. Please store these parts inside or in an enclosed container.

Please send me an electronic copy of your storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3). The plan should be revised to address the storing of used parts. Your SWP3 plan should be reviewed annually or when there is a change in management, as per the general permit.
