NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Childress:

On January 25, 2012, I contacted Amy Childress and discussed the issues from my December 14, 2011 Notice of Violation letter. You informed me that you intend to operate and maintain the sewage treatment system at Edgewater Mobile Home Park. You had stated that you are in the process of purchasing another motor and replacing parts of the one in use.

You have requested the names of wastewater treatment operators working in your area in order to obtain a licensed operator to meet the requirements in your permit. I reviewed the reporting data of several treatment plants nearby and find the following operators: Winelco (513) 755-8050, Perfect-A-Waste (513) 851-8886, Apex (513) 771-3617, Environmental Wastewater Services (513) 526-2077. I believe Dennis Feichtner is affiliated with Environmental Wastewater Services. If you need further technical assistance with maintaining your treatment system you may also contact our compliance assistance staff at (614) 644-2028.

You have stated that you will need a few months to comply with the monitoring and reporting requirements of your permit. Ohio EPA has not received the Discharge Monitoring Reports for November and December, 2011 which are violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit.

Non-compliance notifications were not sent to this agency regarding the above violations, as required by the conditions in the permit. A written non-compliance notification should be sent to me whenever there is a limit violation, plant upset, bypass or monitoring violation.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

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You are required to respond to this Notice of Violation letter in writing by February 10, 2012 detailing the actions you are taking to repair the sewage treatment plant and obtain an operator to take your samples.
