Dear Mr. Nelson:

On November 22, 2006, Levis Town Square Land LLC received coverage under the Ohio EPA General Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (CGP) for the Delaware Stations at Levis Commons project located on Michael Owens Way in Levis Commons, Perrysburg, Wood County. This CGP is still active.

On January 31, 2012, I performed an inspection of this facility. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the CGP. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. As a result of this inspection, it appears that coverage for this site is eligible to be terminated.

Construction activities have been completed with final stabilization achieved on all portions of this site. The CGP requires that a Notice of Termination (NOT) be filed to relieve the applicant of the obligation to comply with the terms and conditions of this general permit including regular inspections of the site. I am enclosing an NOT form to terminate this permit.
