Dear Mr. Doyle:

We have reviewed your Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) covering the months of August 2010 through January 2012 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0009156; OEPA Permit # 11C00003*ED). The specific instances of noncompliance were as follows:

Effluent Violations for August 2010 through January 2012

| Reporting Period | Parameter | Outfall # | Limit Type | Units | Permit Limit | Reported Value |

| September 2011 | Oil & Grease | 001 | Daily | mg/l | 10 | 12 |
| November 2011 | Oil & Grease | 001 | Daily | mg/l | 10 | 21 |
| January 2012 | Oil & Grease | 001 | Daily | mg/l | 10 | 42 |

Finally, please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations of your NPDES Permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

We have reviewed your reports addressing the reasons for the above violations and the actions being taken to prevent further occurrences. No additional information is requested at this time. Future violations must continue to be reported as required by the NPDES Permit as detailed in Part III.12 titled "Noncompliance Notification."
