Dear Mr. Peck:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Reynolds Crossing Section 2 located in Reynoldsburg, Ohio on February 15 and 24, 2012. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, the following items were noted:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

- All barren areas are continuing to be protected from erosion with continual applications of temporary mulch, including the large stockpile on the east side as requested.
- The perimeter controls are maintained with minor exceptions noted on the western perimeter. Please monitor all controls as recent rains have jeopardized intended use.

Post Construction:

- Please indicate in your response what post construction measures are utilized for this section.


