This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection that I conducted on March 21, 2012, at Anchor 204 Business Park located near the intersection of Freedom Way and SR 204. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, we noted the following:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:
