Dear Mr. Bayha:

On February 8, 2012, I conducted an inspection of your facility. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. As a result of the inspection, I have the following comments:

6111.04 states that **(1) No person shall cause pollution or place or cause to be placed any sewage, sludge, sludge materials, industrial waste, or other wastes in a location where they cause pollution of any waters of the state.** The rail offloading area does not meet this requirement. Submit a plan to me on how your company plans to improve the rail offloading area to the point that 6111.04 will no longer be violated. Please also increase lot sweeping frequencies to minimize pollution potential.
