Dear Ms. Thompson:

On April 10, 2012, I conducted a compliance evaluation inspection at the Briar Berry MHP located in Lucasville, Ohio. I was accompanied by Jack Knapp of this office. The purpose of the site visit was to evaluate Briar Berry's compliance with its NPDES permit number 0PV00023\*CD and Ohio Revised Code 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I have the following comments:

1. PART III. 3.A. of the Permit states, "All wastewater treatment works shall be operated in a manner consistent with the following: At all times, the permittee shall maintain in good working order and operate as efficiently as possible all treatment or control facilities or systems installed or used by the permittee necessary to achieve compliance with the terms and conditions of this permit. Proper operation and maintenance also includes adequate laboratory controls and appropriate quality assurance procedures. This provision requires the operation of back-up or auxiliary facilities or similar systems which are installed by a permittee only when the operation is necessary to achieve compliance with conditions of the permit."


**At the time of the inspection, one of the two sand filters was full of water and appeared to be in disrepair. You informed me by telephone on April 13th the filter would be repaired and upon a follow up visit on April 18th, the filter was fixed. In the future, insure that regular maintenance is performed on your treatment system.**

Due to the above comments and review of our files, I rated the area of Operations/Maintenance as **Marginal**. Briar Berry MHP should make every effort to return and maintain the treatment system in compliance with its' NPDES permit.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner. You can benefit economically, help preserve the environment, and improve your public image by implementing pollution prevention programs. 
