**RE: Industrial Storm Water Site Inspection, NPDES Permit # 1GR00083\*EG**

Dear Mr. Gottemoeller:

On Wednesday, May 16, 2012, I inspected Continental Express, Inc.'s, facility near Sidney, Ohio, to determine compliance with its industrial storm water discharge permit. You represented the company during this review.

Based on my observations of the site's operations, it appears the company does not require coverage under the multi-sector general permit issued to industrial facilities. When the current permit expires at the end of December 2016, if "significant" materials present at the site continue to be managed under roof, then the company could qualify for a "no exposure certification". This certification can be obtained by completing the 11 question "exposure checklist" found on page 2 of the form available at the following web link: [http://www.epa.ohio.gov/portals/35/storm/no\\_exposure\\_certification\\_fis.pdf](http://www.epa.ohio.gov/portals/35/storm/no_exposure_certification_fis.pdf).

A copy of the completed form should be submitted to Ohio EPA soon after the next version of the industrial storm water permit is issued.
