**RE: Industrial Storm Water Site Inspections – 1GR00306EG, 1GR00307EG**

Dear Ms. Suttles:

On Thursday, May 10, 2012, I inspected both Honeywell Aerospace facilities located in Urbana, Ohio, to determine compliance with their industrial storm water discharge permits. The company was represented by you and Mark Keller.

Based on my observations, each facility appears to be in compliance with the terms of its industrial storm water discharge permit. All materials used in manufacturing processes at both sites are stored indoors. The only potential sources of pollutants are dumpsters and roll off boxes of varying sizes that are used to store scrap metal and general debris (such as lunch trash) before being hauled away by vendors.
