Dear Mr. Mann:

On Wednesday, May 16, 2012, I inspected International Automotive Components' Sidney facility to determine compliance with its Industrial Storm Water Discharge Permit. You represented the company during this review.

Based on my observations of the site's operations and a review of relevant documents, it appears the facility is in substantial compliance with the terms of its Industrial Storm Water Discharge Permit.

One suggestion to improve the accuracy of the site's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3), is to update the facility map by showing areas on the south and western side of the building in which metal racks and tractor trailers are stored. The plan's narrative should highlight the fact that these racks are typically empty. The plan should also emphasize that all process materials and production-related waste is managed indoors.
