Dear Mr. Schmunk:

This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection that I conducted on April 18, 2012, at Creekside Foods located at 2101 Rohr Road, in Lockbourne, Ohio. I understand that these construction activities are covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following items must be addressed:

**Sediment and Erosion Control:**

It appears that the construction is nearly complete and the entire site has been stabilized. You may submit a notice of termination once there is a good stand of vegetation on the site.

There is a discharge pipe leaving the building near the northeast corner of the building. The discharge appears to be discharging to a storm water tile. Please state the nature of this discharge. Please be aware that you may need to obtain a general discharge permit for this discharge.
