Dear Paul and Phyllis Carver

This letter is written in follow-up to a storm water inspection I conducted of your recent fill activities located at 963 West Orange Road in Delaware County on May 24, 2012. This site (specifically located at N40.17548, W83.0302) appears to be greater than one acre and is currently covered under Ohio EPA's General Storm Water Permit for Construction Activities in the Olentangy Watershed (Permit Number 4GCO00067). Based on my site observations, the following items were noted:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

- Fill activities continues at this site.
- Silt fence along all areas of disturbance must be maintain via your required maintenance reports every seven days or within 24 hours of a rain event equal to or greater than 0.5 inches. A log of all inspections must be maintained on site available for review.
- All disturbed areas must be protected from erosion if they are dormant in excess of 21 days.
