Dear Mr. Lambert:

On April 12, 2012, this writer conducted an inspection of the wastewater treatment plant for the Timashamie Family Campground. At the time of the inspection, the campground was not in operation for the winter months. The intent of the inspection was to evaluate systems operation and maintenance. This facility is currently in compliance with its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The following are findings from the inspection:

1. The WWTP was in operation and operating on a timer for the winter. The aeration color was satisfactory. There was some scum on top of the settling tank. The effluent leaving the settling tank was relatively clear.
2. The dosing chamber was operating satisfactorily. The surface sand filters needed to have a few weeds removed. There were some piles of new sand to be installed. The sand filters need to be leveled and the splash pads brought up to grade. The chlorine contact tank did not have chlorine tablets.
3. A review of the monthly monitoring reports that have been submitted to this office indicated that there was only one dissolved oxygen violation during the period January 2011-May 2012.
4. You have requested to drop to quarterly sampling during the winter months while the park is closed. This should not be a problem unless compliance becomes an issue or if flow increases to a more frequent use during the winter.

The plant is receiving good operation and maintenance and appears well maintained
