Dear Mr. Stropko:

On June 4, 2012, Kelly McVay and this writer conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 6111 Cochran Road, Solon, Ohio, to determine compliance with the Ohio EPA General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Storm Water associated with Industrial Activity #OHR000005. As a representative of 6111 Cochran Road, LLC you were present during the inspection. Along with our observations from the inspection, I have provided comments concerning your permit below:

General

1. This site is the location of 6111 Cochran Road LLC, a warehouse and business office that buys and sells foundry production and processing equipment.
2. Storm drains inside the facility have been capped off.

Inspection Observations

1. Dumpsters in the back of the building are uncovered. One dumpster carries scrap metal and the other carries wood pallets. Keep dumpsters covered by a lid or tarp to prevent the collection of storm water and the formation of leachates.
2. There are no leaks or spills visible in the storage yard, but some parts may leak. Spill kits are on hand inside the garage door if needed. If leaks or spills are seen, clean up immediately and correctly dispose of the waste.

Permit

1. Employee training is provided periodically. Records and sign-in sheets of the training sessions should be kept with the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP).
2. As required in Part 5.1.7 in the permit, you must sign and date your SWPPP including the date of signature.
3. Be aware that, for the new NPDES general permit, there are sector specific requirements based on your Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code. You can find your appropriate sector in Table D-1 of Appendix D in the permit.

Action Items

- Cover dumpster with a lid or tarp.
- Sign and date your SWPPP.
