**RE: Industrial Storm Water Inspections; NPDES Permits 1GR00502\*EG, 1GR000499\*EG**

Dear Mr. Fleming:

On Wednesday, June 20, 2012, I inspected CTL Aerospace's two facilities located near Cincinnati, Ohio, to determine compliance with their respective Industrial Storm Water Discharge permits. You represented both sites during this inspection.

Based on my observations, each site appeared to be in substantial compliance with the terms of this permit. None of what is stored outdoors at the site is considered "significant materials" for the purposes of regulating storm water runoff, but open solid waste dumpsters are enough to keep each site on the hook for industrial permits. Covering the dumpsters so that they are closed, except when waste is added, would allow each site to qualify for a no exposure certification, which lessens the regulatory burden imposed by having Industrial Storm Water permits.
