Dear Mr. Trujillo:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Watson Road Landfill located at North of Watson Road between Jay Road and Summit Street in Licking County on May 25, 2012. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with Ohio EPA's General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, we noted the following:

**Sediment and Erosion Controls**

- During inspection I noted mass grading activities associated with closure/repair.
- Please ensure appropriate sediment controls for all denuded areas.
- Be aware the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days.
