On July 10, 2012, I performed an inspection at the above-referenced site to determine compliance with the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Construction Activities #3GC03503*AG. Our records indicate that Lake Pointe Construction Company was granted coverage under the NPDES permit on September 17, 2007.

It appears that construction activities have never been started. Your permit is NOT under the new provision that automatically expires a permit after five years. You may leave your permit open. Please notify us once construction activities begin on this site.
