Dear Mr. Kushinski:

On July 18, 2012, this writer conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 25850 First Street, Westlake, Ohio to determine compliance with the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Industrial Activity. As a representative of Gardner Denver Nash LLC, you were present during the inspection as well. Along with my observations from the inspection, I have provided comments concerning your permit below:

General

1. This site is the location of Gardner Denver Nash LLC, a facility that services and repairs vacuum pumps, compressor systems and related equipment as described by Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code 3563: Industrial and Commercial Machinery, Except Computer and Office Equipment.
2. Storm water drains flow to a retention pond in the northwest corner of the property. Overflow from the pond enters a ditch, which wraps around the north and east sides of the property. The ditch then flows into a culvert under First Street. It is unknown if it connects to the City of Westlake's MS4 or continues into the pond across the street.

Inspection Observations

1. The waste and scrap dumpsters are both covered. Good housekeeping is being implemented throughout the facility.
2. Routine inspections are conducted around the facility and employee training is conducted frequently.
