Dear Mr. St. Clair:

On July 17, 2012, I conducted an inspection of the wastewater discharge from the water treatment plant (WTP) that serves the Village of Wayne.

At the time of the inspection, the discharge from the WTP had been connected to the Village of Wayne sanitary sewer.

The Village of Wayne holds a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the discontinued direct discharge from the WTP to the Portage River via the South Wayne Ditch. We are in the process of eliminating this NPDES permit. Until you have received a notice that the NPDES permit is no longer required from Ohio EPA, you will need to continue to submit monthly discharge monitoring reports.
