Dear Mr. Papke:

On July 31, 2012, Ohio EPA received a complaint regarding a possible illicit discharge to the municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4). The complainant states that the resident at 7196 Rustic Oval keeps vehicles associated with a landscaping business parked on the driveway. He indicates that these vehicles leak significant amounts of oil that stain the pavement and get tracked out onto the street. The resident is concerned that motor oil, hydraulic fluids and other such materials are entering or will be washed into the storm drain when it rains.

This letter will serve to notify the City of Seven Hills about the possible presence of an illicit discharge. Per the obligations of the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Small MS4s #3GQ00110*AG, please conduct an illicit discharge investigation to determine if an illicit discharge exists and if so, take all steps necessary to remove the source(s) of illicit discharge to the MS4. Please submit documentation of the investigation, its findings, outcomes and plan for corrective action to me **no later than August 31, 2012.**
