Dear Mr. Baker:

On July 26, 2012, I visited the site located on Byesville Road that has a construction storm water permit with the Ohio EPA. The purpose of my inspection was to determine the compliance of this site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for discharges of storm water associated with construction activity. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

No violations of the terms and conditions of the permit were discovered. As a reminder, when individual lots are sold you must submit an Individual Notice of Intent form. Please read the enclosed forms and feel free to call if you have any questions. Please continue to implement permit requirements as construction continues.

As a reminder, if your project disturbs more than five acres you are required to implement post construction water quality volume storage requirements with permanent storm water management structures as required by the permit.
