On August 2, 2012 I performed a compliance inspection for storm water best management practices (BMPs) at the above referenced site. I was accompanied by the following officials for the City of Berea: Tony Armagno, City Engineer, and Tom Ross, City Inspector. Our records indicate that Baldwin Wallace College has obtained coverage under the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Construction Activities #3GC05953*AG.

After review of the site and Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3), I noted the parking lot is almost fully paved and the bioretention swales are starting to be installed. All the sediment controls on site seem to be functioning well. Please continue to repair the controls as needed.
