NPDES Permit Violations**

Dear Mr. Krytus:

We have reviewed your Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) covering the month of June 2012 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit No. OH0127469; OEPA Permit No. 1PR00109*CD). The specific instances of noncompliance and deficiencies were as follows:

In addition, an Annual Sludge Disposal Report is required to be submitted by January 31 of each following year. This requirement is addressed in Part II, Section L of the NPDES permit. The 2011 Annual Sludge Disposal Report has not been submitted as required by the NPDES permit. This report must be submitted at this time.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

Please inform this office, in writing, by August 20, 2012 as to the reason for the above-referenced violation, as well as a description of the action taken or proposed to prevent any further violation. Your response should include the dates, either actual or proposed, for completion of the action. Future violations must be reported as required by the NPDES permit as detailed in Part III.12 titled "Noncompliance Notification."
