Dear Mr. Elliot;

On August 16, 2012, I inspected Elliot Manufacturing, 407 Albert Road, to assess the certification of "No Exposure" that Elliot Manufacturing submitted to Ohio EPA on November 14, 2008. On the day of the inspection, there were no industrial activities or materials exposed to the elements and the claim of "No Exposure" appears to be valid.

If Elliot Manufacturing operations change so that industrial activities or materials become exposed to the elements, then coverage under a general Industrial Storm Water General Permit must be obtained immediately. This can be done by submitting a completed Notice of Intent (NOI) form, along with required fee, to Ohio EPA. The NOI form can be accessed at the following web link:
