Dear Mr. Trembly:

On July 26, 2012, I visited the site located on 990 Ironton Hills Drive in Ironton, Ohio that has a construction storm water permit with the Ohio EPA. The purpose of my inspection was to determine the compliance of this site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for discharges of storm water associated with construction activity. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

No violations of the terms and conditions of the permit were discovered. Please send us a letter stating what your intentions are at this time. There was no construction or hotel located. If there is not going to be any construction please send in the notice of termination that I have attached to this letter.

As a reminder, if your project disturbs more than five acres you are required to implement post construction water quality volume storage requirements with permanent storm water management structures as required by the permit.
