We have used our Surface Water Information Management System (SWIMS) to review your self-monitoring reports covering the months of January through June 2012 and have found no monitoring reports have been submitted for the months of May and June. The failure to submit monthly discharge monitoring reports (DMRs) according to the terms and conditions of your permit is a violation to your discharge permit.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit will result in enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

Please submit the missing DMRs to our Columbus office within 10 days upon receipt of this letter and provide written verification to this office.
