Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter is written in follow up to a construction storm water inspection by Alicia Rector and Elizabeth Pleta of the Ohio EPA, at Abe Miller Poultry Farm located at 7377 Bryant Road on July 19, 2012. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, we noted the following:

- It appears the top soil on location has been removed. Please be aware the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days.
- In addition, please address appropriate sediment controls for this area.
