**RE: Notice of Violation
Kirkmont Center NPDES 1PZ00069**

Ladies and Gentlemen:

According to our records, NPDES permit 1PZ00069 for the Kirkmont Center will expire February 28, 2013. Your current NPDES permit states "In order to receive authorization to discharge beyond the above date of expiration, the permittee shall submit such information and forms as are required by the Ohio EPA no later than 180 days prior to the above date of expiration.". Ohio EPA has not received the NPDES renewal forms, Antidegradation Addendum, or the application fee for this facility, even though it is now less than 180 days prior to the expiration date.

By September 21, 2012, you must submit the NPDES renewal application forms, Antidegradation Addendum and NPDES application fee for the Kirkmont Center NPDES permit. Please be advised that failure to comply with the requirement to submit the renewal application forms for your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.
