Dear Mr. Benkovic:

On September 18, 2012, I inspected CIL Isotope Separations in Xenia, Ohio, to assess the certification of "No Exposure" that was submitted to Ohio EPA on July 16, 2008.

On the day of the inspection, there were no industrial activities or materials exposed to the elements and the claim of "No Exposure" appears to be valid.

If the facilities' operations change so that industrial activities or materials become exposed to the elements, then coverage under Ohio EPA's Industrial Storm Water General Permit must be obtained immediately. This can be done by submitting a completed Notice of Intent (NOI) form, along with required fee, to Ohio EPA. The No Exposure Certification form must be submitted to Ohio EPA every 5 years. In order to maintain your "No Exposure" status, you will need to re-submit the No Exposure form to Ohio EPA on or before July 15, 2013. The No Exposure Certification form and instructions can be found at:
