Dear Mr. Brennan:

This office has reviewed the Discharge Monitoring Reports submitted to Ohio EPA for the period of June 2012 through August 2012. The review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. The specific instances of non-compliance are as follows:

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limits or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 6111. A response to this Notice of Violation is required by October 19, 2012 discussing causes of the above violations as well as actions taken or proposed to prevent their reoccurrence. Please discuss the status of the proposed sewer connection as well.
