This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection I conducted on August 3, 2012, of the construction activities at PC Acres Subdivision located along Royalton Road, in Ashville, Ohio. The Agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following was observed or discussed at the site:

There was no construction activity and no homes were being constructed at the site during the inspection. The site was stabilized and no erosion was leaving the site. You are compliant with your general storm water permit. Please be aware that if home building commences, that the General Permit mandates that all barren areas which remain idle areas in excess of 21 days be protected from erosion (i.e., seed and straw), within seven days from the last construction activity
