Dear Mr. Bill Lozier:

This letter is written in follow up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Blacks Road Project LIC-C.R.34-0.75 located at Blacks Road and Watkins Road. on July 26, 2012. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, we noted the following:

Sediment and Erosion Controls

- During the inspection I noted the initial excavation on Blacks Road. In addition, I noted the perimeter silt fence associated with this recent excavation.
- The silt fence on the north side is improperly installed and not receiving drainage from the site. Corrections must be made to ensure off site storm water flows are properly treated prior to discharge.
- I recommend a series of check dams within the road side ditch to address this issue.
- Be aware the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days.
