On September 25, 2012, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection at C & D Disposal Technologies. The inspection was conducted to evaluate the facility's compliance with federal and state pretreatment regulations and its Indirect Discharge Permit (IDP). Dennis Scugoza, Maintenance Manager, represented C & D Disposal Technologies during the inspection.

General Facility Description

C & D Disposal Technologies is a construction and demolition debris landfill. The facility landfill currently has two cells, Cell 1 and Cell 2, located on opposite sides of a hill. Leachate for each cell flows by gravity through a collection system surrounding the perimeter of the landfill to a sump. Each cell is equipped with a pumping system and an 8000 gallon double wall steel leachate storage tank.

The Jefferson County Board of Health denied the facility's operating license for 2012. It was reported the landfill is able to receive only brick, block and soil and conduct salvage operations at this time. No wastes were observed arriving at the facility during the inspection. The facility reported it is currently unable to pay for the leachate to be hauled to the Jefferson County "M" POTW for treatment. C and D Disposal Technologies and representatives of Jefferson County "M" reported that no leachate has been hauled to the POTW since May of 2012.

C & D Disposal Technologies is regulated as a Significant Industrial User by Ohio EPA. C & D Disposal Technologies is authorized by its IDP to discharge leachate to the Jefferson County "M" POTW.

Comments

1. C & D Disposal Technologies is required in Part III, Paragraph 3 of its IDP to submit effluent monitoring reports during the months of January and July of each year. C & D Disposal Technologies did not submit reports for the January through June 2011, July through December 2011 or January through June 2012 reporting periods, which is in violation of the IDP requirements. Please submit the missing reports using Form 4519 via e-DMR for the above referenced reporting periods by December 1, 2012. If there was no discharge during the entire reporting period, you may check the "no discharge" box on the reporting form.
2. C & D Disposal Technologies' IDP expired in March, 2011. To maintain its authorization to discharge leachate to the Jefferson County "M" POTW, C and D Disposal must apply for renewal of the IDP. C & D Disposal Technologies has the option of requesting revocation of its IDP, or of maintaining the IDP. To maintain the IDP, C & D Disposal Technologies needs to submit a renewal application to Ohio EPA within 60 days. If you choose the former option, please submit a written request for revocation of the IDP to this office.

It may be advantageous for C & D Disposal Technologies to maintain the IDP in the event it reopens or sells the facility. If the IDP is revoked, the facility would need to apply for a new permit before being able to discharge leachate. If C & D Disposal Technologies chooses to apply for renewal of the existing IDP, then the facility were to be reopened or sold, there would be no delay to receive authorization to discharge leachate to Jefferson County "M". Any new owner would need to promptly apply to Ohio EPA for a transfer of the effective IDP in accordance with Part III, Paragraph 14 of the IDP.
