This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection that I conducted on November 9, 2012, at Boar's Head Refrigerated Foods located at 2225 Spiegel Drive Columbus, Ohio. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following associated with construction activities at this site:

**Sediment and Erosion Control:**

It appears that construction is complete at this site. It appears that most of the barren areas had final stabilization at the site. Please be aware that the definition of final stabilization is to have a density of 70% coverage without any large barren areas. It does not appear that the site currently meets the definition of final stabilization at this time. There are several barren areas at the site that will require re-seeding in the spring. Please see attached pictures.
