Dear Mr. Alsip:

On October 24, 2012, I visited the facility located on Schuster Road. The purpose of my inspection was to determine the compliance of this site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for discharges of storm water associated with industrial activity. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

**Your facility appeared to be in compliance with the General Industrial Storm Water Permit that has been issued to you by the Ohio EPA. Please continue to implement permit requirements in the future.**

**It was noted that the possibility exists for permit requirements to be violated in extreme rain events. Ohio EPA recommends that you assess the concern and install a system that will ensure no wood debris are passed through the treatment system larger than 1 inch in size. Please refer to the section of the permit that deals with wet deck areas for more clarification on the requirements.**
